Fall eave cleaning to be done within the first two weeks of November.






Reminders

REDUCE USE

Lawn watering – Alternate day and time restrictions (odd numbered address, odd numbered calendar day, even number address, even numbered calendar day, between 7-9 a.m. and 7-9 p.m)

Watering trees, decorative (e.g. flower) and food gardens – no restrictions. **Recreational sprinklers for children, splash pads** – no restrictions. **Filling residential swimming and wading pools, hot tubs, garden ponds or fountains** – no restrictions
