## Winter is in the Air

The snowy season is here again. With it comes some changes here in our co-op!

### **Snow Removal:**

The plow generally will not go within 2 feet of any parked car. If we have had a big snowfall and you see the plow here, go and move your car to the street so your parking spots can be cleaned, otherwise shovel your spot.

### **Parking:**

Please keep in mind where you are parking. Now that winter is here the snow removal contractor needs room to put the snow pile left after plowing the parking lot. This year the middle parking area has the back 4 spots visitor's parking on either side of the median will be used as snow dump area. The spots in front of 44 will now be visitors parking.

Please see that you and your guests adhere to the no parking signs. If no parking is available in the visitor spots please have your guests park along the street.

Reminder there is also no overnight parking on the street during a snow event according to City of Guelph bylaw. Overnight parking passes for our visitor spots remain available from Joan in the office.

### **Salt:**

Please salt the sidewalk front of your home. Salt is available in the community center.
